DECONSTRUCTION ~ DONATION

Our projects this month include multiple properties across Manhattan, The Bronx, and Queens highlighting the supply of materials available for architectural salvage.

Property salvaged includes 100+ year hardwood flooring, granite architectural interior and exterior ornaments, limestone cladding, wrought iron railings and ornaments and historically significant stained glass windows.

CORPORATE DECOMMISSIONS ~ DONATIONS

Another project in Cincinnati, OH includes a large multi-floor unit with contemporary office furnishings, fixtures, high-quality ceiling tiles, and mechanical machinery that is being donated and saved from the landfill.

Also in Ohio, is a donation of exterior fine art installations pursuant to a full historical mansion deconstruction and renovation.

MORE DECONSTRUCTION IN CHICAGO

Chicago offered our team an additional three large projects this past month, which have included corporate donations of excess hotel furniture, electronic equipment from a corporate decommission, as well as interior solid wood custom doors and interior windows and millwork from a law firm.

FINDING VALUE

Donated materials include:

- Exterior cladding and masonry
- Structural lumber
- Appliances, commercial and residential
- Doors, windows, lighting, fixtures
- Plumbing fixtures
- Machinery and equipment including HVAC, heat pumps, solar panels, hot water heaters, fire mitigation systems
- Office furniture (although quite difficult to place, except for office chairs!)
- Electronics including phone and computer systems and hardware
- Office materials and supplies
- Architectural ornaments including stained glass, cornices, carved structures, religious salvage
- Marble, granite, limestone and other stone elements
